Trauma Intervention Programs, Inc has been awarded the prestigious Paul H. Chapman Award from the Foundation for the Improvement of Justice. This award is given to innovative organizations whose efforts have made a positive difference to the criminal justice system in the United States.

In 2009 there were 150 organizations which competed for this award. Six organizations including TIP received it. Award recipients are organizations which assist victims including victims of domestic violence, human trafficking and child abuse. TIP was given an award because of its work assisting victims of traumatic events across the country.



The award was presented to TIP Board Chairperson Rose Hancock and Orange County TIP volunteer Mindy LaTendresse at the Four Seasons Hotel in Atlanta. Ms. Hancock and Ms. LaTendresse had the opportunity to present the TIP Program at the awards ceremony. According to Ms. Hancock, those in attendance were very impressed with TIP. *“The reaction we received after our presentation from those at the dinner can only be described as . . . WOW,”* said Hancock.

The Paul H. Chapman Award includes a \$10,000 check which TIP will use to continue its efforts to expand its program nationally.
